Oliver Anderson provisionally suspended from playing professional tennis

Australian tennis player Oliver Anderson has been provisionally suspended from playing professional tennis by independent anti-corruption Hearing Officer Richard McLaren.

The suspension applies with immediate effect and will remain in place until the conclusion of Tennis Integrity Unit investigations. During this period Mr Anderson, currently ranked 1083, is excluded from competing in, or attending, any tournament or event organised or sanctioned by the governing bodies of the sport.

The suspension is not a determination of the player's guilt or innocence of corruption offences under the Tennis Anti-Corruption Program.
