

CAS UPHOLDS SANCTION IN THE CASE OF PATRICIO HERAS

The Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS) has dismissed an appeal from Argentinian tennis player Patricio Heras against a disciplinary sanction imposed on 3 September 2018.
